

Privacy Policy

www.caparalegalservices.com ("we", "our" or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how www.caparalegalservices.com collects, uses and discloses your personal information.

This Privacy Policy applies to our website, www.caparalegalservices.com and its associated subdomains (collectively, our "Service") together with our application, www.caparalegalservices.com. By accessing or using our Service, you indicate that you have read, understood and agree to our collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Service.

Definitions and Key Terms

To help explain things as clearly as possible in this Privacy Policy, whenever any of these terms are referred to, they are strictly defined as:

Cookie: small amount of data generated by a website and saved by your web browser. It is used to identify your browser, provide analytics, remember information about you such as your language preference or login information.

Company: When this policy mentions "Company", "we", "us" or "our", it refers to www.caparalegalservices.com, which is responsible for your information under this Privacy Policy.

Platform: www.caparalegalservices.com Internet website, web application or public-facing digital application.

Country: where www.caparalegalservices.com or the owners/founders of www.caparalegalservices.com is located, in this case it is USA

Customer: refers to the company, organisation or person that registers to use the www.caparalegalservices.com Service to manage relationships with its consumers or service users.

Device: any device connected to the Internet, such as a phone, tablet, computer or any other device that can be used to visit www.caparalegalservices.com and use the services.

IP Address: Every device connected to the Internet is assigned a number known as an Internet Protocol (IP) address. These numbers are usually assigned in geographic blocks. An IP address can often be used to identify the location from which a device connects to the Internet.

Personnel: refers to those persons who are employed by www.caparalegalservices.com or are under contract to perform a service on behalf of a party.

Personal data: any information that directly, indirectly or in connection with other information, including a personal identification number, allows the identification of a natural person.

Information collected automatically

There is certain information such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address and/or browser and device characteristics, that is collected automatically when you visit our platform. This information can be used to connect your computer to the Internet. Other information collected automatically could be a login, email address, password, computer and connection information, such as browser plug-in types and versions and time zone settings, operating systems and platforms, purchase history (sometimes we add similar information from other users), the entire Uniform Resource Locator (URL) clickstream to, through and from our website which may include date and time; cookie number; parts of the site you viewed or searched for; and the phone number you used to call our Customer Service. This information does not reveal your specific identity (like your name or contact information), but may include device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name device, country, location , information about who and when uses our information and other technical information. This information is primarily necessary to maintain the security and operation of our platform, and for our internal analysis and reporting purposes.

Business Sale
